*If time is limited, questions 1 and 2 are the key questions and provide enough to run a search. In question 2, entering the place where the person currently lives is sufficient.*

**Other members of the family**

People can sometimes get grants because of members of their family. For example there are a number of charities for the dependents of people who worked in particular jobs or were members of certain trade associations. Or people can get grants because they look after someone who is disabled or ill or frail.

*Looking at questions 2-8, are there any members of your family that you think it might be worth providing information about? If so please provide relevant details.*
